AMONGST THE BEST IN THE WORLD



The importance and objectivity of wine competitions are not seldom up for discussion. It is often claimed that luck plays a bigger roll than superiority, especially when the same wine scores widely opposite results in different competitions.

With **Bon Courage Inkára Shiraz** no luck is involved. The results are impressive and consistent. Not only did this wine become **Best South African Shiraz** in a national Shiraz competition (Pick & Pay Wine Magazine Shiraz Challenge 2007), but it has now also won gold medals at **Syrah-du-Monde** for two consecutive years.

Syrah-du-Monde is the world's number one Shiraz competition. This year there were 384 entries from 23 countries. A total of 36 gold medals were awarded, one of which to the Inkára Shiraz 2006. South Africa won 5 gold medals, the Inkára being the only Robertson medalist.

It is interesting to note that although France had 47 wines entered compared to South Africa's 14, they only managed to win a total of 7 gold medals.

The judges summarized their tasting notes as follows:

Black cherry colour with deep purple tinges. The nose is open and complex (brandy-soaked fruit, floral, Virginia tobacco and strong oak (roasted coffee)). Round and full, velvety and lively, ripe and fresh, showing a bit of hotness. Some menthol on a long finish.

So, enjoy another world-class wine from Bon Courage!
